
## 2007 High-Energy-Density-Physics Summer School University of California, San Diego July 29 - August 4, 2007



The 2007 High-Energy-Density-Physics (HEDP) Summer School, a biannual event organized by the Fusion Science Center for Extreme States of Matter and Fast Ignition Physics, will be held at the San Diego Campus of the University of California, La Jolla, California, July 29 – August 4, 2007. The Summer School is for those undergraduate seniors, graduate students, postdocs, and researchers who want to enter, or advance their knowledge in, this new and exciting field of HEDP. Lecture topics include radiation transport and spectroscopy, hydrodynamics, laser-plasma interactions, and experiment diagnostics, along with other ongoing research activities in the area of HEDP. A number of scholarships covering meals, lodging, and travel expenses are available to the undergraduate seniors, graduate students, and postdoc participants.
